#### **Overview of the Multiplier Event**

The Ukrainian Multiplier Event was held online on June 30, 2025, from 15:00 to 18:00 Kyiv time. The event gathered 32 participants representing academic and management staff from Sumy State University. Promotion was carried out via the E-cabinet of Sumy State University, targeted faculty email lists, and professional networking platforms such as LinkedIn.

The event was framed as "Generative Artificial Intelligence Day", serving as a platform to present and disseminate the project results of DialogEduShift. The sessions were facilitated by Yuriy Zuban, Director of the Center for E-Learning Technologies, and Svitlana Tarasenko, As.Professor at the Department of International Economic Relations. Both presented the project's intellectual outputs, including:

- Manual for HEIs on the Use of Artificial Intelligence
- Guidelines for Academicians on the Usage of AI Conversational Bots (LLM Models) in HEI
- The possibilities of digital avatars for teachers
- Online course for teachers "The Usage of AI Chat Tools in Higher Education"
- Video product.

The event was considered a success. Participants actively engaged in the discussion session, sharing concerns about ethical use of AI, evaluation of AI-generated assignments, and the risks of plagiarism. Key challenges such as limited awareness of AI's potential and uneven levels of digital readiness were overcome through demonstrations of project outputs and practical cases.

The benefits to participants included access to structured guidelines and teaching resources, enhanced awareness of Al's opportunities and risks. The event's impact is visible in the increased commitment of participants to pilot Al-based practices within their institutions and to disseminate the project results among their colleagues.

#### **Profile of Attendees**

The Multiplier Event gathered 32 participants: 17 women and 15 men, representing both academicians and management staff of university. The participants' age group ranged mainly from 30 to 55 years, with professional backgrounds in economics, philology, computer science, pedagogy, and education management.

#### **Overview of Feedback from Attendees**



Feedback was collected through oral contributions during the discussion and via online survey distributed during the event in Zoom tool. Participants noted that the Guidelines and Manual offered much-needed clarity on ethical aspects of AI use and provided practical steps for classroom integration. Many expressed interest in the online course as a tool for professional development.

Survey results indicated that:

- 88% found the event highly relevant to their professional activities
- 85% considered the project results as directly applicable within their institutions.

Overall, the Multiplier Event achieved its goals: it strengthened awareness, disseminated project outputs to a broader academic audience.




