Overview of the Piloting Event

The piloting of the online course took place between June and August 2025. A total of 40 participants (6 men and 34 women) from various higher education institutions in Ukraine joined the piloting process. Participants represented different age groups ranging from 25 to 60 years and came from universities including V. N. Karazin Kharkiv National University, Ostrohradskyi National University, Kyiv National University of Trade and Economics, Ivano-Frankivsk National Medical University, and Kyiv National Economic University named after Vadym Hetman.

The online course was promoted through LinkedIn posts targeted at academic educators and university communities.

The online course piloting engaged educators from diverse disciplines and institutions. One of the main challenges was the different levels of digital skills among participants. The overall impact of the piloting is strengthening of digital competences among educators, and the development of perspective on how AI can be useful in higher education teaching and evaluation.

Profile of Attendees

The piloting brought together 40 participants representing a diverse demographic and professional background. The group consisted of 6 men and 34 women, aged between 25 and 60 years. Most of the attendees were university lecturers, associate professors, and researchers with teaching experience in social sciences, economics, medicine, and humanities.

The participants directly matched the project's target group, higher education educators seeking to strengthen their competences in AI using. They demonstrated interest in adapting their teaching practices to the challenges of AI integration.

Overview of Feedback from Attendees

Feedback highlights several key outcomes:

- 1) Participants found the course relevant and emphasized that it provided systematized knowledge on the use of AI chatbots in academia;
- 2) Many appreciated the practical orientation of the modules, particularly the ones on assessment and plagiarism.
- 3) Participants noted that the course offered useful AI resources that they could apply in their teaching practices.

Overall, the piloting is evaluated positively.
